EUROPEAN FISHERIES CONTROL AGENCY (EFCA) – CONTRIBUTION TO TITLES 1, 2 AND 3.

Legal basis: Article 35(1) of Council Regulation (EC) No 768/2005 of 26 April 2005 establishing a Community Fisheries Control Agency and amending Regulation (EEC) No 2847/93 establishing a control system applicable to the common fisheries policy (OJ L 128, 21.5.2005, p. 1) as amended by Regulation (EU) 2016/1626 of the European Parliament and the Council of 14 September 2016 (OJ L 251, 16.9.2016, p.80).

Subject: The subsidy is intended to cover the Agency's staff and administrative expenditure and operating expenditure. The European Fisheries Control Agency was created by Council Regulation (EC) n° 768/2005 of 26 April 2005. Its mission is defined in Article 3 which was modified in 2016 in order to incorporate the Coast Guard functions. The agency has been operational since 2007. Its estimated budget for 2017 is conform to the draft budget proposed by the European Commission and voted during the Administrative Board held on 11.10.2016.

Amount: € 17 021 000.
