This will require a long-term effort to progressively build the capacity to effectively address this challenge. This effort should be undertaken collectively with the MS in order to foster a reinforced evaluation culture in both DG MARE and the MS.</p> <p>The contract foresees the provision of support services to help the Commission undertake a set of tasks linked to this new monitoring and evaluation system and fulfil the new obligations included in the Common Provisions Regulation.</p> |
